

Zygote Press Printmaking Residency Award 2010

Zygote Press announces the 2010-11 Printmaking Residency Award that is offered to a graduating printmaking student from Northeast Ohio universities the opportunity for a three-month free residency at Zygote Press to be used through out the academic year. The residency includes full access to the shop, locker and flat file storage, access to all (supplied and included) materials/equipment, inclusion in Zygote's archive collection and discounts on classes and workshops for three months. We urge all Graduate and Undergraduate printmaking students to apply. It is possible for people applying to Graduate programs in the fall to utilize the three months during the summer. All full applications are reviewed by an artist resident, Board member and a member of the staff.

Zygote Press is a non-profit, artist run organization located in Cleveland, that offers facilities for intaglio, relief, letterpress, silkscreen, waterless lithography, Xante and photo-crossover techniques. This is an exceptional opportunity to work independently within a shop atmosphere. This program was designed for recent graduates to see artists continuing their work outside of an academic facility. This award can be used for any consecutive three- month period during the 2010-11 academic year. The recipient, in exchange for their residency, will donate to Zygote Press archives (1) print from every edition pulled at Zygote, benefiting both the press and the recipient artist.

The application packet must include:

- 10 (print-related) digital images of work
- Descriptions of work, title, medium, size and year completed
- Artist statement and resume
- SASE enclosed envelope (If you need materials returned)

Application deadline:

- 4pm on March 19th.
- Winner Notification by April 2nd.
